


### LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH

- <sup>9</sup> Because of the house of the Lord our God, I will seek to do you good."


### **SECOND READING: Romans 13:11-14**

And then the deaf will hear, the blind will see Him clear, the mute will find their voice, the lame will leap for joy, prepare the way of the coming of the Lord!



### THE GREAT THANKSGIVING


- P The Lord be with you.

Save us from the time of trial and deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and forever. Amen






