FIRST READING Genesis 1:1—2:4a

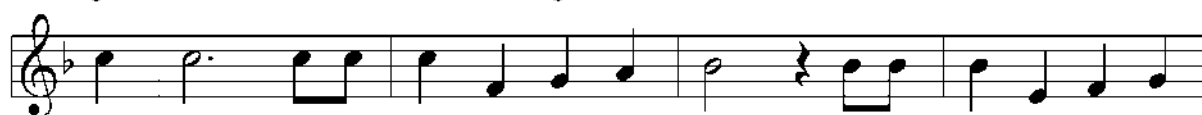
